- i X Incorrect page margins: Pagmargins must be 1 ½ inches for left margin, 1 inchright page margin, 1 ¼ inch for bottom margin. The top pagemarginvaries. Pages with ajor headings need a 2 inch top page margin, most pages will require a 1 inch top page margin. Right and bottom page margins and page number placement remains there
- î X Pages are incorrectly numbered. Preliminary pages must be numbered with lower case roman numerals (exaniplie; i iv). Your paperstarts on page 1. This is the introduction or Chapter One.
- i X Lacking required elements of a thesis dissetation: Your paper must include Signature page, Title page, Table of Contents, AbstractIntroduction, Review of Current Knowledgescription of yourt8dy, Results Analysis/Conclusion, Impact/Implications, References, and Biographica8ketch. A List of Tables, List of Abbreviations, Appendices are equired if those tements are present in your paper. Theonly exception is Creative Writing.

- í î XEt al. shoud not be used in the Reference section. Leaders usually indicate many authoritse only exception is when your style guide specifically states otherwise.
- i i XTables and figures shouldnot be imbedded in the text of the paper. 3 single blank line spaces should parate a table or figure from the text of the paper and/oreach other, above and belowlf a table and caption appears are on a page; should have a 1 high top page margin. A figure and its caption should be centered vertically on page when possible put
