

New Process for Awards that Provide Scholarship Funding with Monitoring Requirements

Background

The University of South Alabama has various grants that provide scholarship opportunities for students. Many of these require the student recipient to fulfill specified services or employment after graduation, such as taking specific courses as well as working in a certain field or area of the country for a specified period of time. In these cases, the students are responsible for completing the required specifications to keep the scholarship from becoming a loan which must be repaid. In addition to the student's responsibility to fulfill specific requirements, the University is responsible for monitoring and ensuring that all criteria of the grant are met and that the student meets the requirements.
